Club Rules.

Social play on the courts is permitted all year round from 10.00am until dusk (latest 9.30pm) with the exception of when a planned club event is in progress.

2. If other members are waiting to play on the courts then those already playing should give way at the end of their current set.
3. Members are asked to show every courtesy to other members of the club, visiting teams and the club's neighbours. Aggressive behaviour or abusive language will not be tolerated
4. Members are asked to park their cars on the Community Center or Cricket Club car parks and not in front of the Cottages.
5. Members must follow "good practice" with regard to the courts: No mud to be brought on shoes, remove any litter, cans etc from the vicinity of the courts, no chewing gum, no cigarettes and the courts must be swept after use with court brush supplied
6. The last player remaining on the courts must ensure that the gate is locked upon leaving. Members must have a key to the courts with them in case they are last to leave.
7. In a season, a member may bring up to three guests free of charge however an individual non-member can only visit the club a maximum of three times as a guest of any member in the same season
8. Keys to the courts must not, under any circumstances, be loaned to non-members
9. Tennis trainers must be worn on the courts if playing tennis. I.e. footwear that will not damage the courts

Junior Rules

10. All general rules apply
11. Parents will be held responsible for the conduct of their children whilst using the courts and children will be deemed to be under their care at all times.
12. The courts and surrounding area must not be used for any activity other than Tennis i.e. no footballs, bicycles etc.
13. Juniors members are not permitted to bring guests to the club

Please note that failure to comply may result in expulsion from the Club.
